An Insurance Company may be in affiliation with another "inspection organization" to provide Code inspection services as long as the "inspection organization" providing code inspection service on behalf of the Insurance Company has Code Inspectors holding the appropriate National Board Commissions and/or credentials (e.g. Certificate of Competency, or jurisdictional commission), where applicable.

The name of the inspection organization will not be included on the Certificate, e.g. DBA (doing business as) will not be used on a Certificate. Only the name of the Insurance Company as defined in Part 5, 5-1.1.1(b) shall appear on the Certificate.
