The course will cover the following topics:

- Scope Delineation, Insurance considerations and ethical considerations for “engineer-of-record” customarily associated with various project delivery methods (Woods & Aitken)
- Development of Contract Provision with most litigated provisions for engineers in the construction (Woods & Aitken)
- Contract Administration Best practices and activities (Woods & Aitken)
- Risk Management Discussion with Loss Prevention in construction, Equipment Exposures, Fire Protection and Dust Hazards (FM Global)
- General Lessons Learned and Open Forum (Open Discussion)
