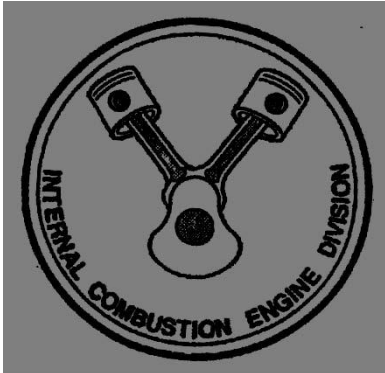

Only the **top 20** abstracts will be invited to showcase their research posters at the 3rd Graduate Student Work-in-Progress (WIP) Research Poster Session on **November 4th, 2018** at the **Opening Reception** of the 2018 ASME Internal Combustion Engines Fall Technical Conference. The posters should be no larger than 48” x 36”. Poster boards and easels will be provided at the conference venue.

You must be an ASME student member and a graduate student on the date of abstract submission, and you must register for the conference to present your poster.
